## **RAINING THEME 001**

## INNOVATION FOR SUSTAINABILITY

In today's rapidly changing world with challenges getting more complex and systemic, the role of innovation in attaining sustainability has become critical and imperative. Innovation for sustainability refers to the ideation and application of new ideas, products, services, processes, systems and models that aim to create a net positive and sustained impact for people and nature.

This training programme offers a deep understanding of the different dimensions of sustainability innovations including Nature-based Solutions (NbS), Social Innovations and Business Model Innovations, and how they could be integrated into corporate strategies, policy frameworks, project proposals, and everyday life.

The training programme combines lectures, case studies, practical workshops, field learning and capstone experiences to offer participants a comprehensive and experiential learning journey.

#### TRAINING OUTCOMES

## Upon completion of the training, participants will:

- Understand the drivers and conditions for innovations that bring positive change
- Critically analyse sustainability challenges from an innovative and creative mindset
- Apply the sustainability knowledge into the process of creating and implementing new ideas, processes, management systems and community partnerships

#### KEY KNOWLEDGE AND SKILL SETS

The training programme will be structured into either a one-day experiential learning or a 3-day programme\*. The key learning topics may cover:



Science, Policy and Practice of NbS — understand the conceptual framework, practical planning and design challenges of applying NbS through lecture and field trip

Social Innovation for Sustainable Communities — delve into various social innovation models and community partnership strategies, and learn community mapping and engagement through experiential workshops on selected environmental or social themes

03

Social Entrepreneurship for Sustainable Food Systems — learn the potential of driving Sustainable Food Systems with social entrepreneurship, and explore different means to support our local food systems

- Suitable for supervisors, middle and senior management in business or non-profit organisations of any size; especially relevant to those in the role of facilitating a sustainability mindset and culture in organisations

## TRAINING THEME 002

## **ESG AND CIRCULAR ECONOMY IN PRACTICE**

Amidst global threats including climate emergency, resource scarcity and waste crisis, embracing sustainability in businesses' and organisations' operations and value chains has become imperative.

This training programme is designed to empower participants with essential practical knowledge and skills to navigate the complexities of sustainability confidently. The two half-day workshops will delve into emerging environmental, social, and governance (ESG) trends and opportunities; engage participants in hands-on activities with tools to develop actionable strategies on sustainable value chain (SVC) management; and immerse participants in a design thinking process for resource circularity.

This training incorporates real-life case studies, business visits, group discussions and brainstorming sessions.

#### TRAINING OUTCOMES

## Upon completion of the training, participants will:

- Reframe their understanding of ESG and sustainability, and their significance within the business context.
- Renew their perspectives of the broader ESG landscape
- Grasp the key principles of SVC management
- Cultivate a circular economy mindset for business / organisational planning
- Create an action plan with practicable steps for resource circularity goals and communicate the impacts effectively with key stakeholders

#### KEY KNOWLEDGE AND SKILL SETS

The training programme will be structured flexibly between 6-10 hours\*. The key learning topics may cover:

Starting with the Foundation — unravel the difference between sustainability and ESG, and understand their practical implications for corporate and organisational development

02

#### Practicing SVC Management —

dissect your organisation's value chain, and address the pressing ESG challenges

03

Seeking Inspiration — be empowered with practical tools to critically assess and enhance the organisation's sustainability readiness

04

Planning a Pilot Project — collaborate with peers to create an implementation plan for solving a selected sustainability challenge

## TRAINING THEME 003

# DISABILITY INCLUSIVE WORKPLACE & DIVERSE WORKFORCE

Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion (DEI) is rising in prominence as one of the more measurable metrics for "S" in Environment, Society, and Governance (ESG). Since an inclusive work environment engenders a sense of belonging and positively impacts organisation's culture and workplace wellness, corporates are gradually tapping into diverse talent pools and creating workplace that is value-added for corporations and disabled talents.

Equipping participants with the knowledge and skills to understand and promote disability inclusion and its essentiality for businesses, this programme will explore and examine different DEI strategies and metrics, easing the participants' organisations into a disability-inclusive corporation through experiential learning.

The programme combines lectures, case studies, company visits, and role play to offer participants a comprehensive learning journey.

#### TRAINING OUTCOMES

## Upon completion of the training, participants will:

- Understand the meaning of 'Disability Inclusion' and recognise its importance to corporates
- Attain practical knowledge for Disability Inclusion, from recruitment policies, job arrangement, to fostering a favourable environment for success
- Acquire essential communication skills for interacting with People with Disabilities (PWD), and enhancing staff readiness to co-create a respectful workplace
- Equip with knowledge and skills to measure the impact of disability inclusion initiatives



#### KEY KNOWLEDGE AND SKILL SETS

Subject to the organisations' awareness level, experience, and readiness regarding inclusive employment, the training module can be selected individually or in a bundle \*. The key learning topics may cover:

Disability Inclusion Implementation from a Corporate Perspective — devising appropriate strategies by showing various practices in different industries

02

Boosting Diversity and Inclusion in Recruitment
— blending disability inclusion in the recruitment process and developing talent management strategies

03

Building an Accessible and Inclusive Workplace — providing principles and practical guidance on fostering a supportive corporate environment, and designing effective measurement and narrative strategies

04

Inclusive PWD Interaction and Communication Skills — applying inclusive language to engage respectfully with PWD colleagues and clients

Impact Measurement and Presentation on Disability Inclusion — designing effective measurement strategies and narratives to demonstrate
